A leader in the field of transformational studies in trauma treatment, Fosha's work focuses on integrating neuroplasticity, recognition science and developmental dyadic research into experiential clinical process work with patients. With AEDP as an internationally recognized approach that specializes in training therapists in a healing-oriented transformational model, Dr Fosha is on the cutting edge of innovation in the treatment of attachment trauma. Changing how we think about change, she is opening up exciting possibilities for what can happen in psychotherapy.
